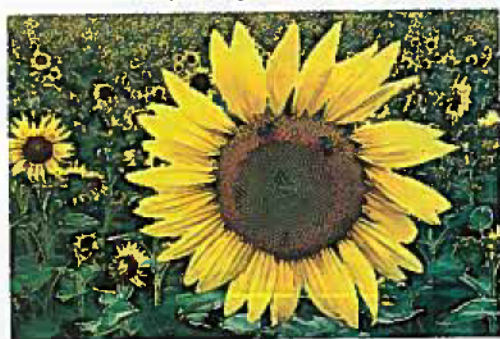


These photos help with fabric selection, perspective, and detail of incorporating a flower in a quilt.
