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## Majestic Moose lap quilt

Make a striking lap quilt with just 2 fabrics when you cut apart the moose quilt panel from the Imagine collection.
Skill level: Easy
Finished Size: $4612^{\prime \prime} \times 59 \prime$
Cutting Instructions: wof $=$ width of fabric
Note: Yardage and instructions are based on fabric that has NOT been prewashed. If you are using the fabrics listed below, please do not prewash them prior to completing the quilt.

| Fabric requirements | Yards | Cutting Instructions |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Fabric A - Deer quilt panel \#DP22565-46 (36"x 42") | 1 panel | - Cut the panel following directions below. |
| Fabric B - Navy texture \#22471-49 | 1112 yards | - Cut 2 strips $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof; trim to $301 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (step 2 ). <br> - Cut 10 strips $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof; join end-to-end and cut (2) 29 " pieces (step 1 ), (2) $301 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces (step 4), (2) $45^{\prime \prime}$ pieces (step 5), (2) $381 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces (step 8), and (2) $53^{\prime \prime}$ pieces (step 9). <br> - Cut 7 strips $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} x$ wof; join end-to-end and cut (2) 9 " pieces (step 3), (2) $243 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ pieces (step 6), (2) $211 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ pieces (step 7), (4) $3^{½ \prime \prime}$ squares (step 7 \& 11), (2) $39^{\prime \prime}$ pieces (step 10) \& (2) 291⁄2" pieces (step 11). |
| Fabric C - Teal texture \#22473-46 | 1/2 yard | - Cut 6 strips $21 / 4^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ wof; join end-to-end, press in half and reserve for binding. |
| Backing | 21/2 yards | - Cut one 67 " piece. Cut balance in half lengthwise, join end-to-end and add to side of 67" piece. |

General Piecing: All seams are $1 / 4 / 4$ unless noted. Press seams toward panel fabric unless noted.

## Cutting the panel:

Note: Press the panel to be as square as possible prior to cutting. Cut along the design lines, adjusting your ruler as required to cut the various width strips.

1. Cut the top and bottom triangle rows along aqua edge; trim rows to $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide, then cut \#6 203/4" long and \#7 143/4" long to include the printed triangles.
2. Cut the side triangle rows along aqua edge; trim rows to $31 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ wide, then cut \#10 and \#11 141/2" long.
3. Cut the side aqua rows along aqua edge; trim rows to $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide, then cut \#3 $22^{\prime \prime}$ long to include the aqua section.
4. Trim center panel to $281 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide $\times 29^{\prime \prime}$ high.


## Piecing: (Refer to layout diagram)

1. Sew a $29^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ " Fabric B piece to each side of panel.
2. Sew a $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 301 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B piece to top and bottom edges.
3. Sew a 9" Fabric B piece to "diamond" end of each \#3 panel piece; sew to top and bottom edges of quilt.
4. Sew a $301 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B piece to top and bottom edges.
5. Sew a $45^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{112 "}{}$ Fabric B piece to each side of quilt.
6. Sew a $243 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B piece to large triangle end of each \#6 panel piece; add to sides of quilt, with triangles adjacent to quilt.
7. Sew a $21 \frac{1}{4 \prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B piece to large triangle end of each \#7 piece, and a $312^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B square to small triangle end. Add to top and bottom edges, with triangles adjacent to quilt.
8. Sew a $381 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B piece to top and bottom edges.
9. Sew a $53^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{112 "}{}$ " Fabric B piece to each side of quilt.
10. Sew a $39^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B piece to large triangle end of
 each \#10 piece; add to sides of quilt, with triangles adjacent to quilt.
11. Sew a $291 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31^{\prime \prime} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B piece to large triangle end of each \#11 piece, and a $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $B$ square to small triangle end. Add to top and bottom edges, with triangles adjacent to quilt.

Finishing:
Layer the prepared backing, a 52" x 65" piece of batting and the quilt top. Baste and quilt as desired. Trim edges even with quilt top. Sew the prepared binding to the edges with a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam, turn and stitch in place. Enjoy your new quilt!
