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Majestic Moose lap quilt

Make a striking lap quilt with just 2 fabrics when you cut apart the moose quilt panel from the Imagine collection.

Skill level: Easy Finished Size: 46½" x 59" Cutting Instructions: wof = width of fabric

Note: Yardage and instructions are based on fabric that has NOT been prewashed. If you are using the fabrics listed below, please do not prewash them prior to completing the quilt.

Fabric requirements	Yards	Cutting Instructions
Fabric A - Deer quilt panel #DP22565-46 (36" x 42")	1 panel	Cut the panel following directions below.
Fabric B - Navy texture #22471-49	1½ yards	 Cut 2 strips 4¹/₂" x wof; trim to 30¹/₂" (step 2). Cut 10 strips 1¹/₂" x wof; join end-to-end and cut (2) 29" pieces (step 1), (2) 30¹/₂" pieces (step 4), (2) 45" pieces (step 5), (2) 38¹/₂" pieces (step 8), and (2) 53" pieces (step 9). Cut 7 strips 3¹/₂" x wof; join end-to-end and cut (2) 9" pieces (step 3), (2) 24³/₄" pieces (step 6), (2) 21¹/₄" pieces (step 7), (4) 3¹/₂" squares (step 7 & 11), (2) 39" pieces (step 10) & (2) 29¹/₂" pieces (step 11).
Fabric C - Teal texture #22473-46	½ yard	• Cut 6 strips 2 ¹ / ₄ " x wof; join end-to-end, press in half and reserve for binding.
Backing	2½ yards	 Cut one 67" piece. Cut balance in half lengthwise, join end-to-end and add to side of 67" piece.

General Piecing: All seams are 1/4" unless noted. Press seams toward panel fabric unless noted.

Cutting the panel:

Note: Press the panel to be as square as possible prior to cutting. Cut along the design lines, adjusting your ruler as required to cut the various width strips.

1. Cut the top and bottom triangle rows along aqua edge; trim rows to $3\frac{1}{2}$ wide, then cut #6 20³/₄ long and #7 14³/₄ long to include the printed triangles.

2. Cut the side triangle rows along aqua edge; trim rows to $3\frac{1}{2}$ wide, then cut #10 and #11 $14\frac{1}{2}$ long.

3. Cut the side aqua rows along aqua edge; trim rows to 3½" wide, then cut #3 22" long to include the aqua section.

4. Trim center panel to 28¹/₂" wide x 29" high.



Piecing: (Refer to layout diagram)

1. Sew a 29" x 1¹/₂" Fabric B piece to each side of panel.

2. Sew a 4¹/₂" x 30¹/₂" Fabric B piece to top and bottom edges.

3. Sew a 9" Fabric B piece to "diamond" end of each #3 panel piece; sew to top and bottom edges of quilt.

4. Sew a 30¹/₂" x 1¹/₂" Fabric B piece to top and bottom edges.

5. Sew a 45" x 11/2" Fabric B piece to each side of quilt.

6. Sew a $24\frac{3}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B piece to large triangle end of each #6 panel piece; add to sides of quilt, with triangles adjacent to quilt.

7. Sew a $21\frac{1}{4}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B piece to large triangle end of each #7 piece, and a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B square to small triangle end. Add to top and bottom edges, with triangles adjacent to quilt.

8. Sew a 38¹/₂" x 1¹/₂" Fabric B piece to top and bottom edges.

9. Sew a 53" x 1¹/₂" Fabric B piece to each side of quilt.

10. Sew a $39'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}''$ Fabric B piece to large triangle end of each #10 piece; add to sides of quilt, with triangles adjacent to quilt.

11. Sew a 29¹/₂" x 3¹/₂" Fabric B piece to large triangle end of each #11 piece, and a 3¹/₂" Fabric B square to small triangle end. Add to top and bottom edges, with triangles adjacent to quilt.

Finishing:

Layer the prepared backing, a 52" x 65" piece of batting and the quilt top. Baste and quilt as desired. Trim edges even with quilt top. Sew the prepared binding to the edges with a 1/4" seam, turn and stitch in place. Enjoy your new quilt!
