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WOF = width of fabric; LOF = length of fabric All seams are sewn using a ¼" seam allowance

Fabric Requirements	Yardage	Cutting Instructions
Fabric A C28066-11	3/8 yd	 Trim the two placemats to 13 ½" x 18 ½" Cut out two of the small blocks at edges of the design (4 ½" x 4 ½" each)
Fabric B 28076-11	1/8 yd	 Cut 1 – 2½" x WOF strip Sub-cut 2 – 2½" x 13½" strips and 1 – 2½" x 4½" strip Trim remainder of strip to 2" Sub-cut 2 – 2" x 4½" strips
Fabric C DP28075-11	1/3 yd	• Cut 4 – 2 ¼" x WOF strips; set aside for binding.
Backing DP28073-78	3/4 yard	 Cut in half across LOF to get 2 – 21 ½" x 27" pieces. Join the two pieces along their short edges to get a backing piece measuring approx. 21 ½" x 53"; press seam open.

Runner Assembly:

- 1. Sew a 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric B strip between the two small 4 ½" blocks. Add a 2" x 4 ½" Fabric B strip to the opposite ends of the 4 ½" blocks. Refer to image for the direction of the floral print. Press all seams toward the small blocks.
- 2. Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $13\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the unit made in step 1 to complete the center unit. Press seams toward the strips. Center unit should measure $13\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".

 Sew the short ends of each placemat to each side of the center unit, again referring to image for direction of each piece.







Step 3

- 4. Join the binding strips using diagonal seams. Fold in half (wrong sides together) along the length of the strip.
- 5. Layer top, batting & backing. Quilt as desired. Bind using your favorite method.
