

CURATED CUTS – AROUND THE BLOCK PATTERN SERIES



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Around the Block in 10" Tiles

Finished Size 57" x 76"

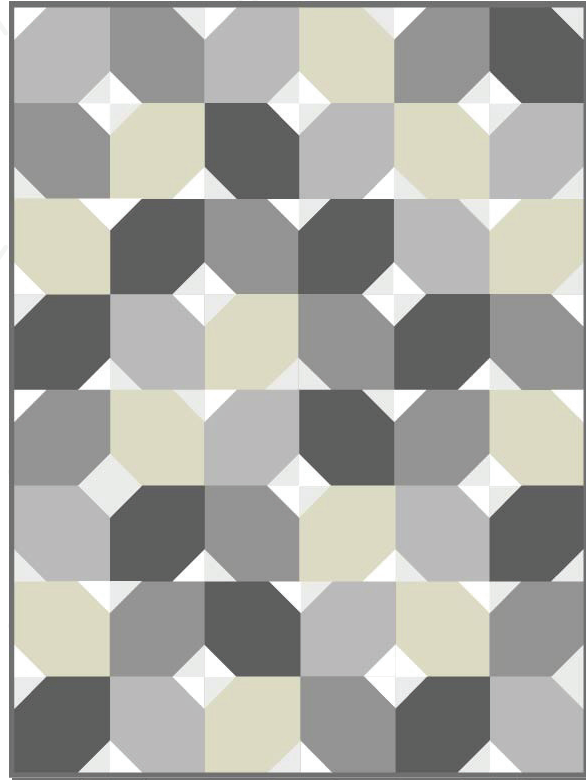
All seams are sewn using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance

Requirements:

12-10" Tiles in Six Coordinating Fabrics
(there will be 2 tiles left over)

Binding – $\frac{1}{2}$ yd

Crosswise Backing – 4 yds



Instructions:

1. From the two lightest fabrics (22 tiles), cut 192 – $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x $3\frac{1}{4}$ " squares for the corner triangles (9 squares from each tile).
2. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each $3\frac{1}{4}$ " square.
3. With right sides together, sew a $3\frac{1}{4}$ " square to two opposite corners of a 10" tile, sewing along the line just drawn. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the sewn line. Press to the outer edge of the block. Repeat for 48 tiles.
4. Using the image as a guide, or choosing your own layout, arrange the blocks to your liking.
5. Sew blocks together in 8 rows of 6 blocks. Then sew rows together to complete the quilt top.
6. From the binding fabric, cut 7 – $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Join strips together and prepare binding.
7. Prepare backing by cutting backing fabric in half along length of fabric to get 2 – 2 yd pieces. Join along selvage edges.
8. Layer quilt top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind using your favorite method.
